
RUNNING A TOWN RECORD OFFICE IN ROMAN EGYPT

Among the holdings of the Chester Beatty Library in Dublin is an unexpectedly substantial body of unpublished Greek papyri. This lecture examines that material, mostly the remains of a number of rolls from the relatively sparsely documented town of Narmouthis, modern Medinet Madi, in the Fayum. They date to a twenty-year period in the 1st century AD and originate in the public record office, telling us much about the running of that office, of its managers and of the activities of the town and its environs.
